As you will certainly remember, you or one of your colleagues at your institution have/has signed the ENES Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to foster the idea of a European Network for Earth System Modelling. The first projects initiated by ENES in the mean been have been successfully completed (PRISM) or are on a good way (ENSEMBLES). Nevertheless, we continuously need your full support for other projects including a better integration of Earth System data bases on a European level or the definition of a European Supercomputing Facility. Such infrastructures will allow European Earth System Scientists to stay at the forefront of their area of research. You will also remember that the MoU signed by your institution was limited in its duration for a three years period.

We are currently drafting a brochure asking for enhanced supercomputing capability in Europe. A draft copy for your review will be sent to you soon.
